

## **Prescribed Fire Notification**

The California Desert Interagency Fire Program (CDIFP) and the Palm Springs-South Coast Field Office are planning to burn at Lake Mathews Monday April 4, 2022, pending favorable air quality and weather conditions. The primary objective of the burn is to maintain Stephens' kangaroo rat habitat and also provide a buffer around burn plots for the field exercises of the Wildfire Cause and Origin Determination (FI-210) course.
